

# “ABOUT ME” BROCHURE



Brochures are handy pieces of paper. They inform us about literally everything and anything! It's important that they have a lot of descriptive and exciting words, as well as pictures and graphics that “sell” an idea, place, product, etc. to other people. Professionals who create brochures need to be good writers in order for the brochures to be successful.

Pretend that a company has ordered a brochure to be made all about *you!* How do you want to be described? A destination? A product? An operating manual? The choice is yours on how you want to describe yourself—but it's important that you be as descriptive as possible.

**Your brochure must include complete sentences that describe the following:**

1. Your physical characteristics
2. Your personality
3. Your likes and dislikes
4. Where you can be found / where you come from
5. FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) people may ask about you

**Your brochure should also feature pictures (drawn or photos/printed) and color on white paper. No notebook paper. It can be folded in any way you wish.**

For full credit, your brochure should:

- Include all 7 requirements
- Be written / presented neatly
- Have no spelling errors
