Poetry Workshop Poetry Book

Now it's time to polish your poems and assemble them into your own Poetry Book. You should have finished your Verb Poem, Monster Poem, Scranimal, and Color Poem rough drafts.

To create your Poetry Book, you need:

- 1. To revise your poems and make sure they meet the requirements for each. Check for spelling, punctuation, word choices, and figurative language!
- 2. Clearly and neatly write each poem on a white piece of paper. Extra credit if you type up your poems. Make sure your stanzas are formatted correctly!
- 3. Include a cover page that has your name and class period. If you would like to title your Poetry Book something other than "Poetry Book," you are more than welcome!

For full credit, your Poetry Book needs to have all of the above. For your Monster Poem, the illustration of your monster can go on a separate page or be drawn on the same page as your poem. Remember, it needs to be colored! No pencil! Your construction paper Scranimal should be glued neatly to a piece of white paper.

Your final project should have a minimum of 5 pages (4 poems, 1 cover). Staple them together or assemble them into a bound cover. 20 points is awarded directly to presentation!
